She would also be a regular alongside Ernie at the Yorkton Threshermen's Show & Senior's Festival where you could see her grinding flour, driving a tractor, or competing in the stooking competition. She loved listening to her daughter play the organ in worship services and concerts. Doreen was honoured to see her grandsons' grow into wonderful young men. Doreen is predeceased by her beloved husband, Ernie (1999); her father, Albert (1977); her mother, Elsie (1998); her brother, Dennis (1995); her sister, Georgina (2002); and niece, Charlene (2008).
