



KOCUR - Dobrodyika Brenda fell asleep in the Lord with her son, Nicholas by her side at the family home in Wakaw on Monday April 19, 2021. She was 56 years of age. Brenda was born Tuesday June 30, 1964 in Pine River, Manitoba to Walter and Nadia (nee Kopachynski) Furdievich. Brenda grew up and completed her high school education in Pine River and then moved to Winnipeg to further her education and to find employment. While in Winnipeg, Brenda worked at St. Andrew's College library and it is here that she met a young theology student and would later marry the love of her life, Roman Kocur. Dobr. Brenda and Fr. Roman were united in Holy Matrimony on August 8, 1992 in St. George's Ukrainian Orthodox Church in Dauphin, Manitoba. Following Reverend Father Roman's ordination they served parishes in Ottawa, Thunder Bay, Wakaw, Yorkton, Saskatoon, and presently Windsor, Ontario. Due to her declining

health and the need for intense medical care Brenda remained in Wakaw, Saskatchewan at the family home while Fr. Roman continued his pastoral work in Windsor, Ontario. Dobr. Brenda is predeceased by her parents, Walter and Nadia; and first born son, Stefan. She is survived by her husband, Very Reverend Archpriest Roman; her son, Nicholas; her two sisters, Marianne Furdievich and Kim (Terry) Urbanski and their two daughters, Emily and Grace; one sister-in-law, Mary (John) Kocur-Stranart and her two sons, Daniel and Andre; one brother-in-law, Michael Kocur; and by many extended family and friends. Funeral services were held on Wednesday April 28, 2021 from Holy trinity Ukrainian Orthodox Church, Prince Albert with Very Reverend Archpriest Michal Lomaszkiewicz serving as the Celebrant. Dobrodyika Mira Lomaszkiewicz served as the Cantor with members of the parish choir assisting in the singing. The interment followed in the South Hill Cemetery (Orthodox Section) with close family and friends serving as the Pallbearers.
