together, watching the birds at the feeders, gardening, especially growing her own roses, and she loved spending time with her friends. Dorothy's love of dancing had her attending dances three times a week. She loved holding Sadie, the family's little Yorkie who gave her great comfort. Most of all, she loved being with her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren; to whom she was very affectionately known as Baba, and Grandma. Dorothy felt very fortunate to have celebrated her birthdate with two special people, her grandson, Ryan, and her granddaughter, Nicole. Dorothy is predeceased by her first husband, Walter in 1999; her husband, Leslie in 2014; her parents, Titus and Pauline (nee Chernetsky) Halarewich; eight sisters, and five brothers.
